## **Facilities/ WHS:**

### **Toilets:**

The new toilets install has started. The new toilets should be working by Friday this week. Once the new toilets are operational, works will begin on the boys' toilet, a new urinal will be installed and the flooring will be resprayed. There will be some paint works in there as well.

## **Curriculum:**

Our reading data has been updated for the end of semester 1. Running records have been completed throughout the school. At this time, 70% of our students have already achieved their end of year benchmark. Based on this data trend, we should get 85% of our students to achieve their reading benchmark!

Preliminary report data shows that 88% of our kids are getting a C or above across their report cards. 95% of our students are getting a C or above in Behaviour.

Our key improvement agenda is that 85% of students are achieving a C or above in English, Maths and Science.

Parent and Carer support: Mrs Wheatley (GO) and I, in conjunction with ME TOO (a support service for children , young people and families), would like to offer some support for families, parents and grandparents through an information session about supporting and developing strategies to work with young people.
