This funding will be used to

- increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 6 achieving at least a 'C' standard in English to 90% in 2018.
- increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 6 achieving a 'B' standard or above in English to 40% in 2018.
- increase the percentage of Prep to Year 3 students achieving NQR reading benchmarks from 81% in 2017 to 90% in 2018.

- Develop staff capability.
- Implement and embed Teaching with a Literacy Focus through the use of Instructional Coaching Cycles.
- Implement and embed collective monitoring of student work.
- Assess and analyse student NAPLAN writing tasks and English Unit work to determine areas for improvement.
- Implement and embed literacy blocks.
- Align human resources to the writing priority.

Actions - 2

- Develop staff capability.
- Implement and embed observation and feedback opportunities for staff to reflect upon best practice.
- Embed reading blocks at the beginning of every day.
- Align human resources to the reading priority.
- Embed intervention for all students below benchmark.
- Identify individual student reading goals and implement targets and next steps for individual students.

Costs – All I4S funding will contribute towards FTE staffing to enable the development of staff capability, observation and feedback opportunities, literacy and reading blocks, instructional coaching cycles and intervention and extension processes.
